

WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY ID?

The Community ID is a photo identification card available to individuals who live in Hunterdon County or within 10 miles of the Fisherman's Mark office at 37 S. Main St. Lambertville, NJ.

The Community ID has many benefits including: improved communication with law enforcement and medical personnel in a time of an emergency. Additionally, the ID is recognized by the City of Lambertville and can be used to access city resources. Fisherman's Mark and other organizations across the region are working to expand the program. The more you use the ID, the stronger the program grows!

HOW DO I GET ONE?

Community IDs are distributed through Fisherman's Mark by appointment

WHAT WILL I NEED?

When applying for the Community ID, you will need:

- Proof of residency
- Proof of your identity (see list of acceptable proofs)

WILL MY PRIVACY BE PROTECTED?

YES! All information shared with Fisherman's Mark is confidential. We will not retain copies of the documents you present to apply for the ID. You are not required to report your immigration status. Also, you may choose the gender identity on your card without additional documents.



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Applying for the Community ID requires at least **4 points to prove identity** and **2 points to prove residency** in the service area. Please note that this is only a partial list of accepted documents.

IDENTITY Four (4) Points –

- U.S. or Foreign Passport
- Driver's License or State issued photo ID Card
- U.S. Lawful Permanent Resident Card
- U.S. Employment Authorization Card
- Prison Release Letter/ Discharge Papers

IDENTITY Three (2) points—

- Foreign Consular ID Card with photograph
- Certified Copy of US or Foreign Birth Certificate
- National identification card (Must have photo, name, address, DOB and expiration date).

IDENTITY Two (2) points -

- U.S. Public Benefits Card (SNAP or NJFamily Care Card etc.)
- U.S. or Foreign military identification card
- U.S. high school/college transcript
- Proof of minor child enrolled in U.S. school

RESIDENCY IN FISHERMAN'S MARK SERVICE AREA (all of Hunterdon County and addresses within 10 miles of our office)

RESIDENCY * Two (2) points-

- State of N.J. Driver's License or ID Card with photo and address
- Utility, cable or phone bill
- Bank statement
- Hospital or health care bill
- Current lease or mortgage statement

RESIDENCY One (1) point -

- Employment pay stub with address
- Written verification from a hospital, clinic, social service agency, shelter or family member attesting applicant has been a resident for at least 15 days.

*Proof must be from the past three months and include applicant's name and full address.
